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The icons used in the sheets were taken from <https://icons8.com/>. The sheet **can** be used and printed freely after purchasing this homebrew. They **cannot** be resold.



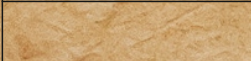
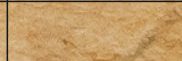
