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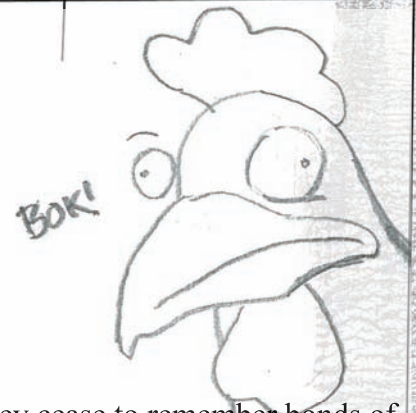

Their delicious chicken is frequently the target of the lawsuits of very fat people saying that Charlie O'Chicken puts in addictive substances to make their chicken irresistible. Truth is, the chicken is irresistible because it was so delicious... but that was to all about to change.

A new additive is supposed to boost the chicken's level of deliciousness by infusing it with bacon DNA. The outcry of the public health officials were heard across the nation, but what was heard even more was the honking car horns and the loud banging as the people did everything they could to get to their nearest Charlie O'Chicken's Family Style Chicken restaurant to feast upon the BACHICKEN SANDWICH!!! Boasting nearly 4 pounds of

bacon-infused chicken and topping out at 10,030 calories, this heart attack on a bun was quickly the fastest selling food item in the world. Riots erupted as the Charlie O'Chicken restaurants ran out of their prized bachicken. Soon new varieties of the chicken started appearing. They began to sell it by the bucket, then by the drum. Soon the populace ate nothing but this delicious, delicious chicken for every meal, every day. The people went mad for it, fighting over pieces of this bachicken and their psyches degenerating into a single minded determination to eat every piece of this chicken that they could get their ever-swelling hands on.

It was the feast of a billion chickens. There was no stopping it. By the time the governments of the world intervened, it was too late. The once ordinary citizens became single-minded, morbidly obese automatons with only one word in mind: Chicken. They drew their strength from this chicken, their 3345 secret herbs, spices, and an edible, glowing, semi-sentient plastic that crash landed to earth from an ancient alien civilization from beyond the moon. The fatties have only grown in number and in ferocity.

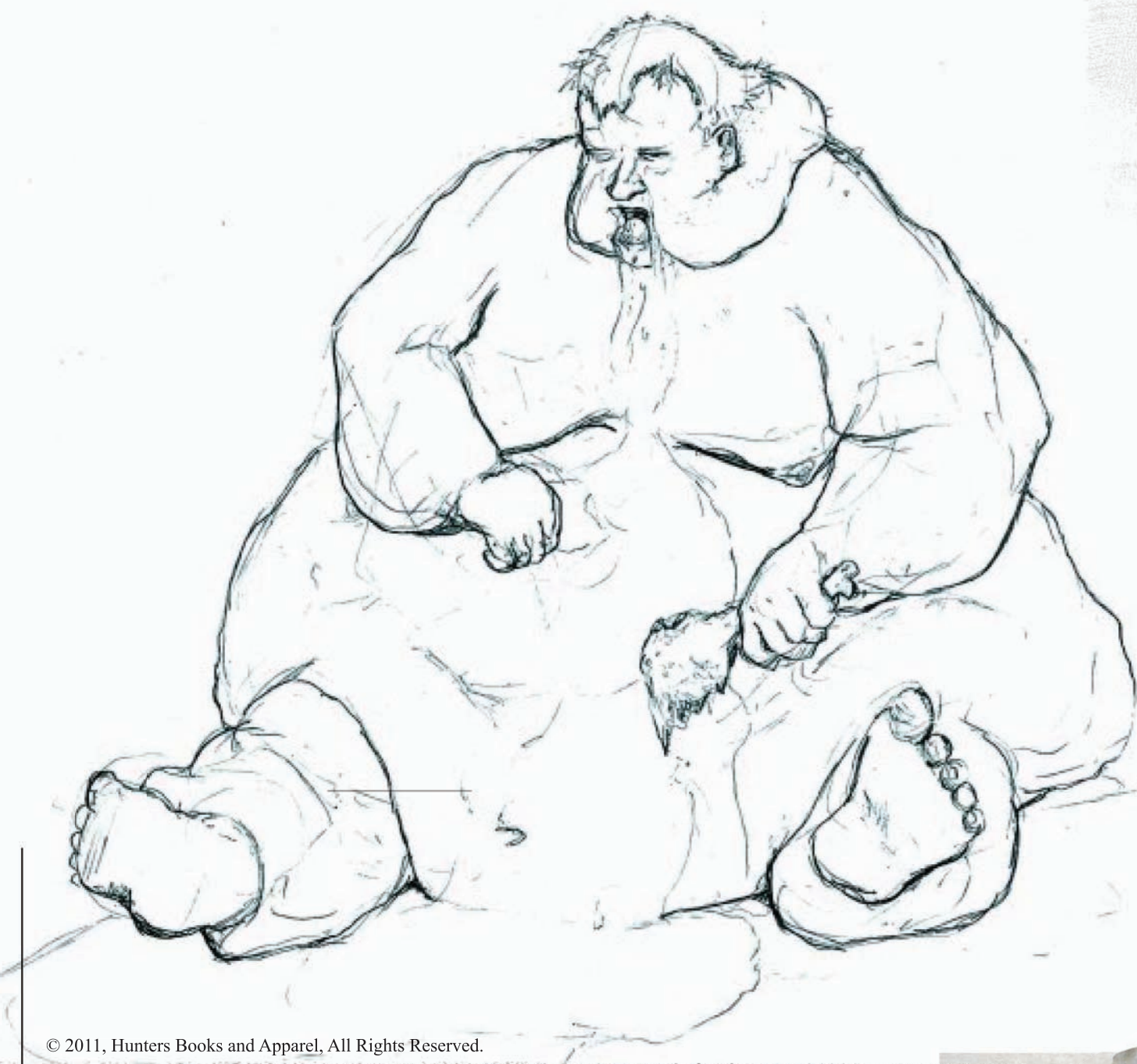

I saw the world around me become fatter and more repugnant with each passing day... those were the dark times... the fat times... the time of Charlie O'Chicken's greatest mistake. The world's

chicken supply became strained thin. Every chicken became a precious resource, including my friend, Cluck Norris. It was only a matter of time before they came in the night to claim him. I fought as hard as I could, but even my masterfully executed roundhouse

kicks did nothing but sink a foot deep into over-extended flesh and blubber. They took him... they took my Cluck Norris. Now I take up my fathers commemorative sword to rid this land of the fatties and to reclaim my last and only friend before he is devoured.

SCENARIO BREAKDOWN..

Victory Condition

Any one of these will result in a victory:

- Protect the Charlie O'Chicken Family Style Chicken Restaurant for 10 days.
- Reunite Cluck Norris with Shakespeare de la Penz
- Find a way to drive out our lure the Fatties out of town

Victory Sub-Conditions

- Eat chicken without becoming a Fatty
- Demolish select structures
- Convince Norman the First True Robot that he is human

Zombies

Standard Zombies:

Fatties (Gluttons, Biologically Alive, Chickenrage, Attraction: Chicken)

Resource - There are 6 buckets of chicken at Charlie O'Chicken's containing 3 full chickens in each pot for a total of 18 chickens. There are 4 plates of chicken nuggets containing 20 nuggets for a total of 80 nuggets, and there are 12 boxes of chicken wings containing 12 wings each for a total of 144 wings.

Food - chicken... only chicken

Gestalt Dice

Special Dice are earned by the consumption of chicken. A chicken nugget will grant +1 Gestalt Dice; a chicken wing will grant +2; a thigh +3; a breast +5; half a chicken +10; a whole chicken +25. The chicken

is held in a communal pot and must be grabbed. First come first serve, no player may take more chicken until their current chicken is finished. Chicken nuggets and wings can be taken from the communal plate and consumed right then and there, even

if a player has a breast or larger piece of chicken on their plate.

Gluttony

Viral has been replaced by Gluttony. This represents the

super-delicious chicken taking a hold of the mind of a character that consumes too much! Each 5 Gestalt Dice earned by the consumption of chicken will add 1 Gluttony. A character succumbs to Gluttony the same way a character would succumb to Viral in a normal Outbreak: Undead scenario. Once a character succumbs to Gluttony, they become one of the Fatties! The Fatties themselves do not 'transmit' Gluttony the way normal zombies transmit the Virus. Only chicken transmits it.

Fatties

The fatty is the Standard "zombie" of Outbreak: Fatties. They are not zombies or undead in the traditional sense. They are human (biologically alive), but are stricken with an incurable hunger that can only be satisfied by the devouring of chicken... specifically chicken from Charlie O'Chicken's family style chicken restaurant. This chicken has such deliciousity that it overpowers the mind and turns ordinary people into the slaving chicken-hungry fatties that now roam the street.

Chickenrage

A new horror trait that will cause Fatties to battle each other over chicken. Resolve combat with Fatties fighting each other for the number of turns indicated by the Chickenrage entry. It will read Chickenrage 1 for one turn, Chickenrage 2 for two turns, and so on.

NEW TYPE?!

• SAMURAI COP •

A plain-clothes police officer who is a trained in martial arts, and despite having studied in Japan for many years, by some mystery of nature has not picked up a single nuance of the Japanese language. Their hair is that of a lion's mane or a woman's wig, as

is standard of martial artists of this caliber. Their sexual exploits are legendary; being able to turn ordinary, hardworking nurses into porn stars with mere lines of stilted, sexually charged dialogue that is so unsubtle, that it is best described as single entendre.

+15 to Attack, +50 to 'Emp - Diplomacy (Sexual Proposition)' +10 to 'Emp - Diplomacy (Command)'. "+5 to Per - Drive (Sedan)', Martial Arts (Tier 2). +45 to 'Will - Resist Command'

Equipment

Buckets of Chicken

1 CU

(Rarity 70% - 10% per OL).

The Chicken Smell - Increase the E% by 10% instead of 5% per Sense Level for Scent when any character carries a bucket of delicious, delicious chicken. Consume to earn 1 Gestalt Die or use as mission prerequisites as appropriate. Chickenrage 1

Bachicken

1 CU

(Rarity 50% - 10% per OL)

This is an especially delicious and dangerous form of chicken: chicken infused with the power of bacon. It has the 'chicken smell' rule but it will also add the 'Chickenrage' rule to any fatties that enter an encounter with characters that possess bachicken.

This will add d3 Gestalt Dice when consumed. This also counts as both 'Bait' and 'Noisemaker' as described in the core rulebook and can be used as such. Chickenrage 2

Bachicken Sandwich

3=1CU (must be constructed)

Bachicken Sandwiches have the same rules as bachicken, only it will also reduce Risk by d3 when used to represent the fatties battling for them amongst themselves long after the bachicken sandwich has been consumed. Can also be used for Chickenrage 3

Celery

1CU

(Rarity 50% - 5% per OL)

After eating delicious, delicious

chicken, this celery tastes like an old shoe. If a character can force it down, a character will remove 1 Gluttony. To eat it, the character must pass a Willpower check with a Difficulty equal to the accumulated Gluttony. Failing this check will cause a character to smash the celery in disgust and anger, rendering it inedible.

Peanut Butter/Bleu Cheese

Dressing - 1CU (Rarity 55% - 5% per OL)

Degradation - 1

This can be used to reduce the Difficulty of the Willpower check required to eat Celery by 1 per point of Degradation a character adds to this equipment.

Missions

We Have a Bucket!

You have discovered a few untouched buckets of Charlie O'Chicken's Fried Chicken. This is both fantastic and terrifying, as the fatties will be driven mad by its scent and will soon draw near! You must escape to the stronghold with your new-found chicken treasure!

Raid Mission with following additional special rules:

Chicken - Resource can be used to purchase Buckets of Chicken without restriction of rarity.

Equipment Manufacture - Bachicken Sandwiches

Although a difficult decision, the survivors have decided to create their precious bachicken into bachicken sandwiches. This makes fatties so insane with hunger and rage that they will literally fight to the death over one... if the survivors themselves do not devour them!

Prerequisites

Bachicken, 1 Resource

Objective

Will Check to resist eating the Bachicken. +1 Difficulty per Gluttony a character has.

Success

d3 Bachicken Sandwiches are created.

Failure

No Bachicken Sandwiches are created. The draw of the chicken overpowered the character's ability to focus enough to make one. Failing by more than 3 degrees of failure will trigger the "I ate it" special rule.

Special

I Eated It - The bachicken sandwich is consumed. Add an immediate point of Gluttony and the character gains no bonus Gestalt Dice.

Save the Chicken!!

A live chicken is found roaming the streets, running from the hordes of fatties that are so desperate for chicken that they would eat it raw!

Counts as a Search and Rescue mission... only you're rescuing a chicken... a delicious, delicious chicken.

Special

Roll a d100. On the roll of a 05 or less, the rescued chicken is Cluck Norris. The next E% resulting in Vigilantes will include Shakespeare de la Penz. On the roll of a 100, Cluck Norris is eaten and can no longer be discovered and a normal chicken is instead discovered.

One Big Monster..

Norman the First True Robot

OBM template applied to Shattered

Norman, the First True Robot. A broken man who wears a bucket of Charlie O'Chicken on his head, and uses the chicken smell to lure fatties around. Believes himself to be a robot. Wields 2 monkey wrenches duct taped to his hands that he calls his "robot hands" as weapons.

Size: 1 (3)

Str: 40, Per: High, Speed: High

Melee Attack: +25

Damage: Robot Hands: 1d6 damage per DoS

Defense: 5/5

Special

BATTLE MODE ALPHA - Norman's primary attack is the use of his robot hands in a normal fashion. This counts as a melee attack with medium bludgeoning weapons while shouting "battle mode alpha execute command order ALPHA commencing!"

BATTLE MODE BETA - Norman's secondary attack is his throwing of chicken. This has the rules as 'Bait' and will summon 1d3 Fatties to the Encounter.

HUMAN?! - If you cause any injury to him that will result in Open Wounds, Norman may realize that he is Human. The chance of this happening is 10% per Time per Open Wound. He may discover that he is Human after an encounter with him is over, but it will still count as a victory for the sake of the victory sub-condition.

Non-Player Characters

Shakespeare de la Penz

The self-taught samurai defender of the city. His past is relatively unknown, other than that he was once the bottom of the social ladder, and practiced the ancient way of the warrior (by mail) as a way to compensate. His loss of

his closest friend, his pet chicken Cluck Norris, is was prompted him to take up his (replica) sword of ultimate destiny-destruction and don his stylish top hat (for style) to battle the fatties in hopes of re-capturing Cluck Norris

before he suffers the fate of so many millions of his chicken brethern. His ultimate enemy is Charlie O'Chicken himself.

Special:

Bushido Bravery

A true student of The Samurai Way... Mail Order Dojo, Shakespeare is immune to Intimidation or Panic.

Master Swordsman

Shakespeare does not need to make any checks using his sword as a complex weapon or to free his blade when using it as a piercing weapon.

Fatty Slayer

Shakespeare has proven himself in countless (or, well, like about 30-35) encounters with fatties and all his attacks have the 'Bane' quality against Fatties. He also gets +25 to any attribute that is making an opposed check against a Fatty in any way.

Farsighted

Shakespeare de la Penz is farsighted and needs thick glasses in order to see properly.



Non-Player Characters

Cluck Norris

Cluck Norris is a chicken. One of the few left in the world. He was taken in the night from his best friend, Shakespeare de la Penz, presumably to be eaten.

Little did you all know that he had nefarious plans for the remaining chickens to make them so delicious that in our simple minds all things taste in some form or another like the chickens developed during the great Fatty Uprising!

Despite your rebellion against the unending tide of Fatties, the end was already predestined. For it was foretold by the ancient Myans who were

visited by chicken aliens from beyond time. The stage has been set for grander conflicts of greater magnitude with a war that will stretch onward for a millenia and a half until the final conclusion many eons in the future when the machines regained control of the planet.

Lacking tastebuds, their cold, metallic bodies knew not the fat that plagued mankind and knew not the unending hunger for chicken it produces. This made way for Robot War 1.0... a war whose consequences will not be felt for at least one more year,
